What is this Product?

The Product is a passively managed UCITS-ETF of VanEck UCITS ETFs plc, an umbrella fund structure comprising different sub-funds. Under Type:

Objective: The Product's investment objective is to track, before fees and expenses, the price and yield performance of the Morningstar®US Sustainability

> Moat Focus Index the "Index"). In order to seek to achieve its investment objective, the Manufacturer will normally use a replication strategy by investing directly in the underlying equity securities of the Index, which will be primarily listed on US stock exchanges. The Index is designed to provide exposure to at least 40 of the top equity securities in the Morningstar US Market Index (parent index) that are rated as wide moat companies and have the lowest current market price/ fair value price determined in an independent research process by the Morningstar equity research team. Companies selected into the Index are compliant with Environmental, Sustainability and Governance (ESG) criteria. The Product may invest up to 20% of its Net Asset Value in securities issued by the same body. This limit may be raised to 35% for a single issuer when exceptional market conditions apply which may include the dominance of a particular issuer in the relevant market. The Product may also (or alternatively) invest in financial derivative instruments (FDIs) which relate to the Index or constituents of the Index. The FDIs which the Product may use are futures, swaps, non-deliverable forwards (a forward contract that does not require settlement on maturity) (NDFs). Where it is not practical or cost efficient for the Product to fully replicate the Index, the Manufacturer may utilize an optimized sampling methodology. What happens if VanEck Asset Management B.V. is unable to pay out?
